THE VA MAY PAY FOR TRAVEL TO RECEIVE CARE:

- VA health facility. VA may reimburse for travel to the closest VA health facility that can provide the care needed. If the VA health care provider decides that travel to another VA facility for care is warranted, they'll reimburse the cost of travel to that facility.
- Non-VA health facility. The VA only reimburses for travel to receive non-VA care that has been approved in advance, except in certain emergency situations.
- Mileage driven to and from your appointment. The VA currently pays 41.5 cents (\$0.415) per mile for approved, health-related travel.
- Parking
- Ticket costs for public transportation, including train, subway, bus, ferry, or light rail
