

Exemptions to Level 2 Drought Response

Exemptions

- Commercial agriculture
- Capture and reuse of cooling system condensate or stormwater.
- Reuse of gray water in for subsurface irrigation or non-potable commercial or industrial use
- Use of reclaimed wastewater
- Watering personal food gardens;
- Watering new and replanted plant, seed, or turf in landscapes, golf courses, or sports turf fields during installation and for a period of 30 days immediately following the date of installation. Please submit the Landscape exemption form.
- Drip irrigation
- Irrigation using soaker hoses.
- Hand watering with a hose with automatic cutoff or handheld container.
- Use of water withdrawn from private water wells or surface water by an owner or operator of property.
- Commercial watering plants held for sale, resale, or installation.
- Watering athletic fields, golf courses, or public turf grass recreational areas.
- Installation, maintenance, or calibration of irrigation systems.
- Hydroseeding.

Professional Exemptions

The following commercial outdoor water uses are exempt from the Outdoor Water Use restrictions for Level 2 Drought Response

- Pressure Washing
- Construction site water use
- Watering in of pesticides and herbicides on turf
- Other activities essential to daily business
